Good Friday Penance

This Friday, Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. **Fasting** means that anyone 14 years old (starting the day after one's 14th birthday) up to 59 years of age (the obligation ceases at Midnight between the 59th birthday and the next day) should eat only one larger meal or two smaller meals, with no eating between meals. Pregnant women and people who are sick are not obliged to fast.

Abstinence means that all those 14 years of age and older are to refrain from eating meat or meat products that day (no meat or chicken – fish is OK).

YOU HAVE THE POWER TO SAVE A LIFE – YOURS!

Life Line Screening will be returning to OLR to perform vascular health screenings on **TUESDAY, APRIL 7.**

The screenings that are performed take just ten minutes each, are painless, and accurate. The tests include stroke and carotid artery screening, heart rhythm screening, abdominal aortic aneurysm

screening, peripheral arterial disease screening, and osteoporosis screening. These tests can reduce your risk of stroke, as compromised blood flow can be noted before any symptoms develop. Test results will be presented to you so that you can share them with your doctor. In past screenings at OLR, a number of parishioners were made aware of things that warranted medical attention. At OLR, the four vascular screenings go for \$149.00, and if you add the fifth osteoporosis screening, all five screenings can be had at the discounted price if \$159.00. VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express are accepted.
