"I Love You"

John 13:31-33,34-35

Jerusalem was getting noisy. It was the day before the Passover Festival and the city was crowded with pilgrims. There was an excitement in the air. Food vendors and wine merchants were cashing in on the annual boom in their business.

The sounds of good spirits, laughter and shouting, fueled by plentiful wine, filled the streets. Noise from the crowds babbled up through the second floor window of the room where Jesus and the disciples were sharing the evening meal together. The street noise made it hard to hear Jesus' soft instruction to Judas, "Hurry and do what you must."

The eleven disciples saw Judas suddenly leave the room. He hadn't even eaten. They had no idea that he was going to betray Jesus.

But Jesus knew where Judas was going. He stared for a little while at the open doorway through which Judas had just walked. The disciples waited to hear what he would say.

Jesus took a deep breath and sighed. Then, looking up at them, he answered their questioning eyes: "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him."

The questioning faces remained blank. Jesus went on: "If God has been glorified in him, God will, in turn, glorify him in himself, and will glorify him soon."

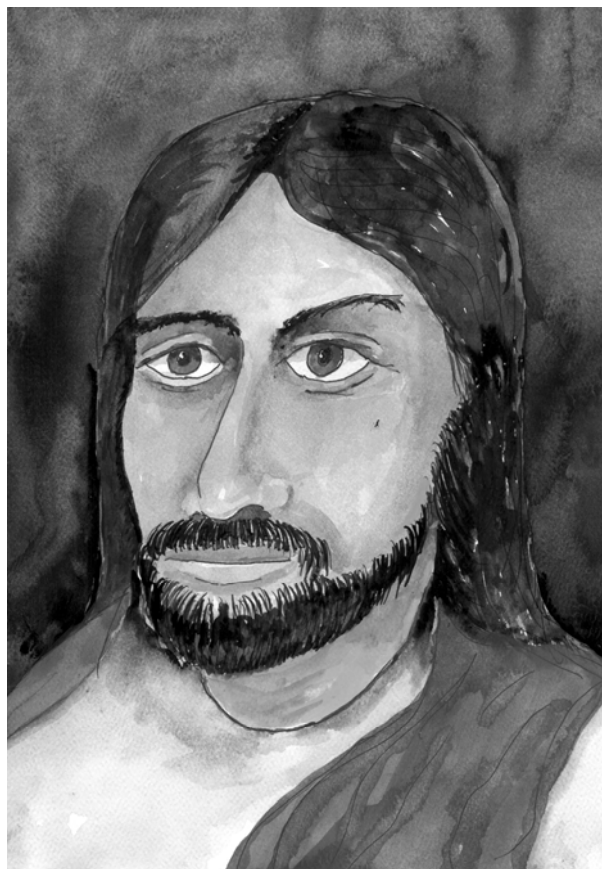
"What do you mean?" Peter asked.

"My children," Jesus said, his eyes softening, "I am not to be with you much longer."

At this they all began to talk at once and combined with the noise from the street the room was a din of confusion.

Jesus raised his hand, seeking their silence. A hush fell within the room and the disciples waited for him to speak.. Even the noise from outside had momentarily stopped.

"I give you a new commandment," Jesus said. "Love one another." Some of the disciples



began to look questioningly at each other.

Philip's hands popped open, seeking more, "But we do love one another," he exclaimed.

Jesus shook his head: "Such as my love has been for you, so must your love be for each other. This is how all will know you for my disciples: by your love for one another." Jesus searched each of their faces and smiled lovingly upon them. It would be for the last time.

Not far away Judas was opening his hand to receive his bribe. Several Roman soldiers and temple guards were being summoned to receive their assignment to follow Judas out of the city and down into the Kidron Valley to the garden of Gethsemane.

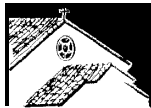
