JULY 8, 2007 – 14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Sending Forth . . .

Luke 10: 1-2, 17-20

It was an impressive gathering. Nearly 100 men stood like an army, ready for battle. Peter and James and John and all the disciples encircled Jesus as he stepped up onto a stone ledge and raised his arms to quiet them. They all looked up, awaiting instructions.

Somehow Jesus had convinced all of these followers to go out and visit all the surrounding towns. Jesus had targeted 36 villages, asking them to go to each in teams of two. They would be reaching Gennesaret, Jotapata, Arbela, Tiberias, Cana, Beth she'arim and the cities to the north in Gentile territory.

The sting of rejection had already been felt by Jesus in Chorazin, a Gentile village only three miles north of Capernaum. There Jesus had been rejected by the people. The same had also occurred in Bethsaida another town in Gentile territory on the way to the Roman bastion at Philippi. And even in Capernaum there were those who would not open their ears to Jesus' preaching.

Jesus looked out at the eager faces remembering how the overwhelmed Moses had called forth God-fearing men to be his helpers. God said to Moses: "Assemble for me seventy of the elders of Israel...and I will take some of the spirit that is on you and bestow it on them that they may share the burden of the people with you."

It seemed in this moment that Scripture was being fulfilled all over again. Jesus' voice was charged with emotion as it rang out over the assembly: "Go! Be on your way. I am sending you like lambs in the midst of wolves." Jesus' outstretched his hands to shower his love down upon them.

His final instructions came rapid-fire: "Take no walking staff or traveling bag. Wear no sandals and greet no one along the way." He told them that when they are invited to stay at someone's home, to bless the house and those within it. He told them to eat and drink whatever they give to them. In this fellowship and hospitality they would find the kingdom. Then,



most importantly, Jesus told the 72 missionaries to spread the news that "...the reign of God is at hand."

When Jesus finished preparing them he blessed them and gave them his peace and his power. Then he sent them out. They would learn in the days that followed that they had the awesome power of his name. They would be able to cast out demons and cure the sick.



We are all asked to be Jesus' helpers. In this Gospel story we can find ourselves among the 72 being sent forth to the towns and villages of our time and place. Jesus has no hands but ours. This is our time to clothe ourselves in his power and go forth proclaiming "the reign of God is at hand."

**CHANGE IN SECOND COLLECTIONS
NEXT WEEKEND – MISSION CO-OP APPEAL**

Next weekend we will have our annual Mission Co-Op appeal. Next weekend's second collection was originally supposed to be for St. Vincent de Paul, and the collection on July 25 was originally scheduled to be the Mission Co-Op appeal – things do change, and envelope schedules are prepared way ahead of time. So if you use offertory envelopes, simply "flip flop" these two envelopes – turn in your Mission Co-Op envelope next weekend, and turn in your St. Vincent de Paul envelope on the weekend of July 24 and 25.

Fr. Briccio Tamoro will be visiting our parish next weekend, will celebrate all of the Masses, and he will be giving this year's Mission Appeal. He has done missionary work for many years in Argentina and Spain. He is presently the Provincial Superior for the Divine Word Missionaries in the Western Province. Fr. Briccio will be speaking in the name of the Divine Word Missionaries which works in 70 countries throughout the world. These missionaries are working on the front lines in the war against poverty and destitution. Some are teaching in colleges and universities, but most are in isolated parishes and outstations, living in great poverty, where tropical diseases are rampant. Your prayers and financial sacrifice for this Mission Appeal are very much appreciated and needed. Besides your prayers, one of the best ways to show our gratitude to God is to make a generous offering to help those who have so very little of this world's riches.

KEEP THE PILGRIMS IN YOUR PRAYERS. It's too early to start thinking about Thanksgiving, but we suggest that you remember the pilgrims – those who are traveling with Fr. Jose on his pilgrimage to see the famous Passion Plan in Oberammergau, Germany and to visit Europe. They will be gone for 12 days as of July 9. May this trip be inspiring to them and their travels be safe.
