NEW ARTICLES

TOMORROW, MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2 IS ALL SOULS DAY. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but a day when many people choose to come to Mass. Mass will be celebrated at 8:15 a.m. and 7:30 p.m.

We extend a special invitation to the family and friends of our faithful departed to attend one of the Masses on this day. The names of our faithful departed who have died within the past year will be posted in front of our Altar of Remembrance, and will be recited during the Mass, so that they will be with us in a special way.

We also continue our tradition of having you bring photographs of your family and friends who have departed, so that they may be placed on our Altar of Remembrance and become part of our celebrations during the entire month of November. Be sure to label these pictures also. They may be picked up in the sacristy starting November 28.

EXPOSITION AND ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT THIS FRIDAY. As this Friday, November 6 is a First Friday, we will have the Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. It will be held in the Chapel from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. There is a sign-up sheet in the chapel with one hour time slots. Please sign up in advance so that we can be assured that someone will be present with the Blessed Sacrament.
